

One way to do the pie contest:

Places a notice in the Mosquito and Carlisle Buzz asking for pies for the contest—
Write up details for our publicity person on timing, accepting pies, and rules about cream pies etc.

Find 5 people to judge--Police Chef is always asked, often someone forgets.

Supplies needed: water, cups, plates (100), forks (100), napkins (100) pie servers and knives, paper towels and wipes to clean up, pencils, tally sheets.

Accept pies until 11 a.m. labeling each with a number and whether or not they are junior or adults bakers.

Set up table to serve pies to townspeople upstairs in FRS vestibule. There is no charge for this however donations are accepted.

Start judging pies at 11 a.m.

Judging: based on appearance, crust, filling, something special.

Collect comments about the pies as judges discuss their findings and reasoning.

Tally results.

Serve pies in the vestibule of the First Religious Society, need two people to serve, and a donation jar.

Announce the winners and award prizes at noon at the Flag Pole.

Clean pie plates cleaned and have ready for pick up by 1:30 p.m.

Send thank you notes to participants.
